Lyngstuva







Lyngstuva 6 km R/T

The far end of Lyngenhalvøya Peninsula is a spectacular area with majestic views of the landscape and fjords. A historic landmark and hub, Lyngstuva is an easy walk along the shore for the whole family. Why not test your fishing tackle on the way? On the way are cultural heritage sights such as Sami and Norse mounds, as well as pits where oil was refined from seals and whales. There is a rustic shelter and toilet at the start of the path. At Lyngstuva is a lighthouse and hut where you can spend the night.
















Drive north past Nordlenangen to the end of the road by Russelva.



The trip traverses easy terrain by service road and path.

Trail description

Lyngstuva is one of the gateways to Lyngsalpan Landscape Conservation Area. From the parking lot at the end of the road on Russelv follow the service road north along the shore. The road eventually transitions to a marked path. After approximately 2,5 km you can turn right to ascend a mount and then continue on a sloping path to the lighthouse. You can also just continue along the shore. Each option offers majestic views of the fjords, Vannøya and Reinøya in the west and Fakken and North Fugløya in the north. Along the way are several campsites, as well as a toilet and a rustic shelter. Have a good trip!
